

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to all visitors and governs data collection and usage. Collection of your Personal Information

We do not collect personally identifiable information from our users. We may gather personal or non-personal information in the future. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of The Community at Rockhill website.

Use of Cookies

The Community at Rockhill website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience.

A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize The Community at Rockhill pages, or register with The Community at Rockhill site or services, a cookie helps The Community at Rockhill to recall your specific information on subsequent visits.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of The Community at Rockhill services or websites you visit.
